Will Kimbrough weaves folk, blues, gospel, jazz and rock 'n' roll to create an unmistakable sound. He has loaned his instrumental and songwriting prowess to a long line of famous names,

including Jimmy Buffet, Rosanne Cash, Steve Earle, Emmylou Harris, The Jayhawks, and John Prine. His song, *Nobody From Nowhere*, struck a chord with Jimmy Buffett who recorded the song for his Buffet Hotel album. But Jimmy wanted more, and tapped Kimbrough for three other co-written songs on Buffet Hotel, including Wings – the title track on Will's 2010 studio album.

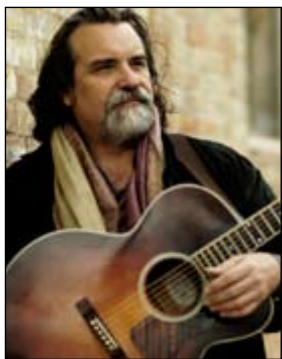
## **A Multifaith Folk and Gospel Celebration**
